

kingdom kids info

At Crossroads we value children as part of our church family. Children are encouraged to participate in the first 15 minutes of church with their families, and then to attend Kingdom Kids for the rest of the meeting time.

At Kingdom Kids the children learn from the Bible through a variety of age appropriate activities such as games, singing, craft and drama.

The school age groups (K-6) are often taught from the same Bible passage as the adults and youth. The younger children are working through a story book Bible.

We hope that this encourages families and the whole church to share what they have been learning together, as well as meeting the needs of various age groups.



leaders and classes

We have a great team of committed leaders who run Kingdom Kids during the school term. Our leaders are required to attend safe church training, as well as training about teaching children. Some of our classes also have parents helping on a roster basis.

The classes are based on age and school grade:

Under 5s:

For children able to sit, up to approximately 5 years of age.

Years K to 6:

For children in years K to 6 at school.



getting to and from kingdom kids

Kingdom Kids classes are located at the opposite end of the foyer, down the corridor on the left.

All children in Under 5s should be escorted to their room by a parent. Please also collect your child from their room at the end of church.



Children from Kindergarten to Year 6 can meet their leaders in the foyer and head to their class from there. Children will be brought back to the foyer by their leaders at the end of church.

Parents are welcome to escort children to their rooms to help them settle in, or to stay with them throughout the lesson.

registration of children

We require registration forms to be filled out for all children attending Kingdom Kids.

Forms can be collected from the information table, and returned to Kerryn Rudder on the day the children are attending Kingdom Kids.
